Eagle Helicopters operates with a staff of 2 pilot loader drivers and additional staff if required. A copy of the company's current Air Operators Certificate is attached.. The company also has a dedicated maintenance and engineering facility approved by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority and hangarage facilities at Southwest Aviation, Cootamundra N.S.W.

Eagle Helicopters is committed to embracing a positive safety culture within its organisation. In order to achieve this, the company employs an active **Safety Management System**, **Fatigue Management System**, stringent **Aviation Risk Management** policies and **Training Programs**.
